Training 10: To like (Part 2)

Hi. I am Marianne. I want to help you learn English. This is a lesson for total beginners or almost beginners. For more advanced courses listen to *“Your English”* or *“QualityTime-ESL Podcasts”*. In this lesson I ask you to repeat certain words and short combinations of words. It is easy. You can find the written script on our website. It is time to start.

You already know the negative form of the verb “like”. Repeat after me “don't like”.

Continue practicing the verb “like” in the negative with the pronouns “I”, “you,” “we”, and “they”.

I don't like	You don't like	We don't like	They don't like
I don't like	You don't like	We don't like	They don't like

With “he”, “she” and “it” the negative form is “doesn't like”. Repeat “doesn't like”. Now go on repeating.

He doesn't like	She doesn't like	It doesn't like
He doesn't like	She doesn't like	It doesn't like

Next comes an exercise. I will say a pronoun, and you will repeat it with “don't like” or “doesn't like” after the pronoun. Listen to the examples.

<i>I say: I...</i>	<i>I say: He...</i>
<i>You say: I don't like</i>	<i>You say: He doesn't like.</i>
<i>I say: You...</i>	<i>I say: She...</i>
<i>You say: You don't like.</i>	<i>You say: She doesn't like</i>

Now you go on. Speak before I give the answer.

I...	He...	You...	It...
I don't like	He doesn't like	You don't like	It doesn't like
You...	She...	We...	They...
You don't like.	She doesn't like	We don't like	They don't like

Next we will say a whole sentence: “I like to drink this.” Repeat after me.

...this.	like to drink this.
...drink this.	I don't like to drink this.

Essential English 08-Like (2) Cont.

Continue repeating:

I...	He...	We...
I don't like to drink this.	He doesn't likes to drink this.	We don't like to drink this.
You...	She...	They...
You don't like to drink this.	She doesn't likes to drink this.	They don't like to drink this.

Next I will say a pronoun, and you will give the whole sentence. Listen to the examples.

<i>I say: I...</i>	<i>I say: She...</i>
<i>You say: I don't like to drink this.</i>	<i>You say: She doesn't like to drink this.</i>

Now you do it. Speak before I give the answer.

I...	He...	We...
I don't like to drink this.	He doesn't like to drink this.	We don't like to drink this.
You...	She...	They...
You don't like to drink this.	She doesn't like to drink this.	They don't like to drink this.

Good work!

Now the interrogative form with "I", "you," "we", and "they". Repeat after me: "Do I?", "Do you", "Do we?", "Do they?" Continue repeating.

Do you...?	Does she...?	Do they...?
Do you like...?	Does she like...?	Do they like...?
Do you like to drink this?	Does she to drink this?	Do they like to drink this?

Now a final exercise. I will give a pronoun, and you will ask the question. Listen to the examples.

<i>I say: You...</i>	<i>I say: She...</i>
<i>You say: Do you like to drink this?</i>	<i>You say: Does she like to drink this?</i>

Now you do it. Speak before I give the answer.

You...	She...	They...
Do you like to drink this?	Does she like to drink this?	Do they like to drink this?

That's the end of this lesson. If you have time, do it again. Thank you for listening. Bye, bye for now.
