Training 2: To have

Hi. I am Marianne. I want to help learn English. This is a lesson for total beginners or almost beginners. For more advanced courses go to our website. In this lesson I ask you to repeat certain words and short combinations. It is easy. It is time to start.

Repeat after me.

I have	He has	It has	You have
You have	She has	We have	They have

Repeat again.

I have	He has	It has	You have
You have	She has	We have	They have

I, you, we and they all take “have”. Repeat after me.

I have	You have	We have	They have
I have	You have	We have	They have
I have	You have	We have	They have

After this an exercise.

I say: I	I say: You	I say: We	I say: They
You say: I have	You say: You have	You say: We have	You say: They have

Now you do the same. Speak before I speak.

I	You	We	They
I have	You have	We have	They have

He, she and it all take “has”. Repeat after me.

He has	She has	It has
He has	She has	It has
He has	She has	It has

After this an exercise.

I say: He	I say: She	I say: It
You say: He has	You say: She has	You say: It has



Essential English 02-To have (Cont.)

Now you do the same. Speak before I speak.

<i>He</i>	<i>She</i>	<i>It</i>
<i>He has</i>	<i>She has</i>	<i>It has</i>

Finally I will say all the persons. Repeat after me.

<i>I have</i>	<i>He has</i>	<i>It has</i>	<i>You have</i>
<i>You have</i>	<i>She has</i>	<i>We have</i>	<i>They have</i>

After this a test—a more difficult test.

<i>I say: I</i>	<i>I say: He</i>	<i>I say: You</i>	<i>I say: It</i>
<i>You say: I have</i>	<i>You say: He has</i>	<i>You say: You have</i>	<i>You say: It has</i>

You do it now. Speak before I speak.

<i>I</i>	<i>They</i>	<i>You</i>	<i>She</i>	<i>We</i>	<i>It</i>
<i>I have</i>	<i>They have</i>	<i>You have</i>	<i>She has</i>	<i>We have</i>	<i>It has</i>

Very good!

*Finally some numbers. You already know the numbers **one, two, three, four, five.***

*Repeat after me the next numbers: **six, seven, eight, nine, ten.***

Repeat again after me: six, seven, eight, nine, ten.

Try to say the numbers before I do. Start.

...six, seven, eight, nine, ten.

*Now repeat from one to ten: **one, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight, nine, ten.***

That's the end of this lesson. If you have time, do it again.
